FAIRFIELD PARK

ROUND LAKE, IL

Location:

On Fairfield Rd., 1/2 mile north of Rte. 120

Directions:

From the corner of Route 120 and Fairfield Road, go North approx.

3/4 mile. The park is

on west side of Fairfield. If you pass Hwy 134, you've gone too far.

Holes: 19

Baskets: DiscCatchers

Tee Pads: Gravel

Leagues:

Thursday 6:00 PM (Summer)

Saturday 11:00 AM (Yearly)

When you pull into the parking lot for the first time you'll ask

yourself, "Is this a pasture?" The first 5 holes are totally wide open, not one obstacle to shoot around. You

had better deuce 4 of the 5 if you expect to have a good round, and that's easier said than done! Winds

can make these wide open holes turn into a nightmare. Add on mid-to-late summer tall grasses and weeds lining the

fairways and finding a drive that goes off course turns into a scavenger hunt. After those 5 holes the

distances and obstacles increase drastically. The woods in the back can quickly eat up those 2's. The back

9 is very tough with a good mix of length and technicality. Watch out for the dreaded SWAMP which comes into

play on #'s 10, 12, & 18. #18 is the longest hole in the state of Illinois. It is well over 800 feet! New in 2003, the

park district has only been mowing the fairways from each tee pad to the basket, adding another
